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The EU copyright protection framework seeks to harmonise while respecting Member State traditions and practices. As regards fair remuneration for artists and right holders, the 2019 Directive on copyright and related rights in the Digital Single Market<sup>1</sup> introduces the binding principle of appropriate and proportionate remuneration.

The Commission, as guardian of the Treaties, is responsible for overseeing Member States' application of Union law. The Honourable Member is invited to put this question to the Commission, as it falls within its sphere of competence.
