The Commission is aware of Decision n° 30239 of 12 July 2022 of the Italian Competition and Market Authority concerning private company Yuka. The Commission does not comment on such decisions taken by the authorities of the Member States.

The Commission is proceeding with its work for preparing a proposal for revising the Regulation on Food Information to Consumers<sup>1</sup> in line with the announcements made in the Farm to Fork Strategy<sup>2</sup> and Europe's Beating Cancer Plan<sup>3</sup> on harmonised mandatory front-of-pack nutrition labelling.

To support the Commission legislative proposal, planned for adoption in the coming months, an impact assessment is being prepared covering different policy options, which are building on existing models currently in use or developed in the EU.

The Commission will prepare its proposal for harmonised front-of-pack nutrition labelling taking into account the results of the impact assessment, scientific advice and the consultation of Member States and stakeholders<sup>4</sup>.
